Williams Gives Curator Tour of BMAC's Exhibits

Brattleboro, Vt. — Fight cabin fever on Sunday, March 2, at 2:00, with a visit to Brattleboro Museum & Art Center, and join BMAC's chief curator Mara Williams for a guided tour through the Museum's current exhibits. Regular Museum admission applies: \$4 adults, \$3 seniors, \$2 students; BMAC members and children 6 and under are admitted free.

Williams's popular tours are full of art history, philosophical concepts, anecdotes, technical analysis, and personal insights. This tour will feature several exhibits, as time allows: the paintings and sculpture of "Networks and Intersections" in the main gallery; Barbara Takenaga's paintings in "Cosmos" and Alisa Dworsky's installation "InTension" in the two small galleries; and narrative paintings in "Worth a Thousand Words II" in the large center gallery.

Other exhibits also at the Museum through March 22 are "Urban Blooms—Ceramic Sculpture by Linda Huey," and "Peter Sís—Tibet Through the Red Box" in the activity gallery.

Founded in 1972, the Brattleboro Museum & Art Center presents art and ideas in ways that inspire, educate, and engage people of all ages. Each season features 12-15 compelling new exhibits of contemporary artwork by regional and internationally acclaimed artists, as well as 30-35 public programs, such as lectures, artist talks, film screenings, and more.

Museum galleries are open year-round, every day except Tuesday, 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.; please check our web site for holiday and other special closings. Regular admission is \$4 for adults, \$3 for seniors, and \$2 for students. Members and children under 6 are admitted free of charge. The Museum Gift Shop is open to the public during regular Museum hours.

The Brattleboro Museum & Art Center is located in downtown Brattleboro, in Union Station at the intersection of Main Street (Route 5) and Routes 119 and 142. The Museum is wheelchair accessible. Parking is available in front of the building. Brattleboro Museum & Art Center's
